Since the weather conditions were awful on Saturday, my boyfriend and I had to go somewhere close to Kent to eat. We decided to try The Pufferbelly LTD. Restaurant on Franklin Ave. We were completely amazed of how good it was and want to go back for another visit!

This little quaint restaurant is cozy inside which makes it perfect for a cold night. The historic building of the restaurant once served as the main railway in the Kent area. Years later, the station has been restored and made into a restaurant with a modern, yet historic look. The restaurant has wonderful service and is set in a very comfortable atmosphere.

The menu offers lots of choices from salmon to outstanding sandwiches. I had the Bourbon Salmon and it was delicious. It had a sweet and tangy flavor to it that went well with my bake potato side. My boyfriend got the Italian Sandwich that was filled with salami and chicken.

The portion sizes are a perfect size. They don't leave you completely stuffed, but definitely content and satisfied. The Pufferbelly also has a wide range of appetizers. My boyfriend and I tried the Shrimp Bruschetta. This dish came with shrimp and a blend of tomatoes, onions, garlic, extra virgin olive oil, fresh basil and Romano cheese. It was also served with grilled focaccia bread. This appetizer was delicious and was just enough to tide us over till our meal.

Pufferbelly also has many sweet desserts for those of you with a strong sweet tooth. Fitting the restaurant well, the menu serves a Train Wreck Brownie Sundae. This treat has chocolate, butterscotch and peanut butter all in once homemade sundae. It is also served warm with peanut butter caramel sauce and whipped cream.
